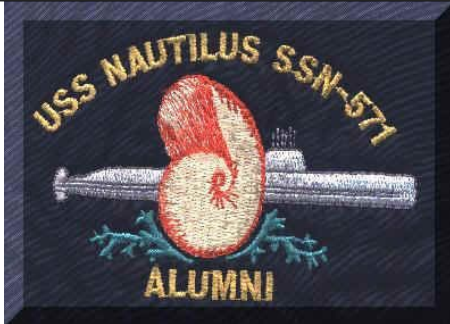

## NAUTILUS WINS 2015 RACE

Dolphin Scholarship Foundation promotes a number of events to support some 115 scholarships including the Nautilus Scholarship. This year's "virtual" race honored U.S. Navy Cold War Sub Vets and involved a secret mission of some 4,312 NM from the Black Sea to Norfolk, VA. Each donation dollar earned a fixed number of nautical miles.

Nautilus has always done well in these races. And, Nautilus won again this year with contributions totaling \$2,278. Our boat trailed the leader, Minneapolis St. Paul, for much of the race. However, we were never far behind and a late surge put Nautilus ahead for good!

Sincere thanks to all of those who participated and proved once again Nautilus proudly wears the title "First and Finest".

## Nautilus Scholarship Fund Achieves 70% of Endowment Goal at Year End 2014!

The Nautilus Scholarship honors crewmembers of USS Nautilus SSN571 and SS168 by awarding undergraduate scholarships to a spouse, child, grandchild, great grandchild, or stepchild, step grandchild or great step grandchild of a current or former crewmember of either submarine who served honorably for 30 days or more.

The scholarship began in 2009. Frank Holland, MMCM(SS), was a driving force behind its creation. Frank was a Nautilus crew member during the 1958 under-ice voyage and an educator after retiring from the Navy.

A scholarship has been awarded in each of the past 6 years. Thank you to all who have supported the scholarship.

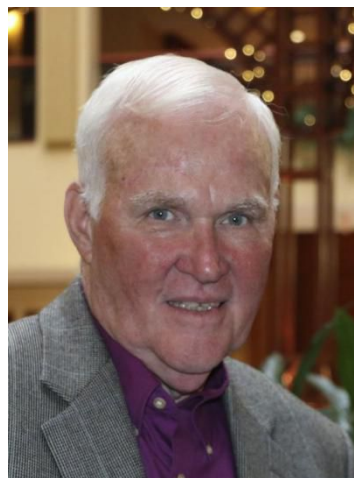

The *Nautilus Scholarship* honors crewmembers of both *USS Nautilus (SSN-571)* and *(SS-168)* by awarding undergraduate scholarships exclusively to a spouse, child, grandchild, great grandchild, or stepchild, step grandchild or great step grandchild of a current or former crewmember of either submarine who has served honorably aboard for thirty (30) or more days.

Applications will be accepted for school year 2016/2017 this fall. Applicants are encouraged to use the Application Check List.
